### A. District Counsel

Mr. Vericker provided a status update of the executed Encroachment Agreements for Mr. Matos and Mr. and Mrs. Procunier.

Mr. Vericker presented Resolution 2019-03, Policy for Easement Encroachment, to the Board for their consideration.

On a motion by Ms. Matthias-Gorman, seconded by Mr. Walz, with all in favor, the Board adopted Resolution 2019-03, Policy for Easement Encroachment, for the Concord Station Community Development District.

Mr. Vericker also discussed the on-going development of a lease agreement with the HOA for use of space in the Clubhouse for an HOA manager. There was a suggestion to collect a nominal monthly fee from the HOA to provide this space.

The Board discussed the tentative plans for the use of office space by the HOA and Mr. Cox explained that the current plans were to offer the use of a portion of the front reception desk for the HOA management personnel.

### B. District Engineer

Mr. Cox and Ms. Stewart provided an update on the status of the Splash Pad. Ms. Stewart requested approval of a proposal from Cornerstone to provide electrical and water connections for the splash pad project.

On a Motion by Mr. Walz, seconded by Mr. Berdeguez, with all in favor, the Board of Supervisors approved the Cornerstone proposal for electrical and water connections for construction of the splash pad in the amount of \$21,000.00, for the Concord Station Community Development District.
