


- Access Cards/Fobs are required to gain access to the clubhouse, fitness center, pool and other areas
 of the facility. These can be purchased at the clubhouse for \$30 per fob. Allowing other patrons to
 enter the facility without a key fob is prohibited.
- Please check the CDD website for Board meeting dates and times.
- The fitness center is open regular hours DAILY, including holidays; 4am to close.

- The Clubhouse is available for party rentals for Concord Station residents. If you are interested in renting, please call or visit the Clubhouse for details. (Use of the pool is NOT included in a rental)
- The fitness center is available for residents ages 14 and older WITH a signed parent
 waiver. Kids 14 and 15 years of age must be accompanied by a parent at all times. Kids 16 and 17
 years of age may use the gym unaccompanied. (Kids under 18 may NOT bring guests.)
- A resident may accompany up to 4 guests per household. There are NO parties allowed on the pool deck.
- When there is lightning in the area, the pool will be closed until it passes. ALL PATRONS MUST LEAVE THE POOL DECK.
- · Please report any incidents and/or issues to the clubhouse staff.
- · Failure to follow the rules may result in suspension of privileges or being trespassed from the facility.
